Many thanks to those who responded to our need for summer clothes for children! Our air conditioner on the food side went out in July! Was it hot!!! Finally got it fixed for a total of \$482. That put a cramp on our finances but we had no choice, especially for a food pantry. Please pray for help on this matter. Somehow we always receive a miracle. God really is good all the time. In July your St. Vincent de Paul fed 72 households, which included 70 children, 76 adults, 13 senior citizens, and 9 homeless.

Money spent for 3,220 pounds of food was \$411.83. Four families were helped with rent totaling \$220. Helping 7 families with utilities cost \$350.82. Thank you for your generous donations that helped so many in need. **Don't forget the "Peace" afghan drawing. This world needs peace!**
